TASTING NOTE

Bright cherry red fruit on the nose, leads onto a crisp palate with low tannins and mouth-watering acidity. Dangerously refreshing.

SHORT HISTORY

Fruit sourced from a local grower in East Sussex.

Terroir: largely clay and clay / sand soils.

Viticulture: conventionally grown, 4000 vines per hectare density, single vsp system.

Yields: 45 hl/ha

VINIFICATION

- Manually harvested into 12 kg baskets.
- Destemmed, whole berries were blanketed with CO2 do encourage carbonic maceration.
- After one day's ferment, the whole berries were pressed into qvevri to finish ferment.
- 100% Indigenous yeast ferment at ambient temperatures.
- Bottled by gravity from qvevri.
- Zero filtration.
- Zero fining.
- Zero sulphur.
